A SUPPLEMENT to "An act concerning county parks, playgrounds, and recreation places, and supplementing chapter 37 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes," approved May 3, 1946 (P. L. 1946, c. 276, C. 40:37-95.1 et seq.).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any full-time employee appointed to office, position or em-  
2 ployment by a county park commission *\*in any county of the second*  
3 *class having a population of more than 460,000 and less than*  
4 *525,000\** pursuant to the provisions of section 4 of the act to which  
5 this act is a supplement (C. 40:37-95.4) shall secure tenure of  
6 office after serving three successive 1-year appointments. Such  
7 employee shall hold and continue to hold said office, position or  
8 employment during good behavior and shall not be removed there-  
9 from except for good cause, upon written charges and after a pub-  
10 lic, fair and impartial hearing before the commission.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Assembly Bill No. 558 concerns the granting of tenure rights to certain full-time employees of certain park commissions.

The bill grants tenure rights to any full-time employee who has been appointed for three successive 1-year terms by the county park commission of the county of Passaic. Upon receiving such tenure rights, no such employee shall be dismissed except for good cause and in accordance with due process.

Section 4 of P. L. 1946, c. 276 (C. 40:37-95.4), to which Assembly Bill No. 558 is a supplement, provides that the terms of office, duties, powers and compensation of all employees appointed by any county park commission shall be determined by the commission, and that such employees shall serve at the pleasure of the commission.
