AN ACT concerning calculation of the life of certain product warranties and supplementing chapter 2 of Title 12A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The warranty of any consumer goods product sold for less
2 than \$1,000.00 which is for 90 days or less shall start running on
3 the date ****[of the sale,]**** *** the consumer goods product is received*
4 *or installed,*** and the calculation of the termination date of such
5 warranty shall exclude any period of time the **entire** product
6 ***or part thereof covered by warranty*** is in the possession or
7 control of the seller, or an agent of the seller, for repairs or other-
8 wise. **Nothing herein shall be construed as limiting in any way*
9 *any warranty on any consumer goods product.**

1 ****2.** *As used in this act, "consumer goods product" shall mean all*
2 *goods or products sold for personal or household use, excluding*
3 *those goods or products used in trade or for commercial purposes.***

1 ****[2.]**** **** 3.**** This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

ASSEMBLY, No. 934

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: APRIL 24, 1975

This bill provides that a warranty of 90 days or less of any consumer goods product sold for less than \$1,000.00 shall run from the date of installation or receipt rather than from the date of sale as presently provided.

Further, the bill as amended provides that in calculating the termination date, the warranty shall exclude periods during which the product or its parts are in for repair. The bill expressly provides that it is not intended in any way to be a limitation on the warranty.
