INTRODUCED MAY 1, 1975

AN ACT to amend "An act concerning motor vehicle special learners' permits, and supplementing article 2 of chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes," approved May 10, 1950 (P. L. 1950, c. 127).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1950, c. 127 (C. 39:3-13.1) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles may issue to
4 a person over 16 years and 6 months of age a special learner's
5 permit, under the hand and seal of the director, allowing such
6 person, for the purpose of fitting himself to become a motor
7 vehicle driver, to operate a dual pedal controlled motor vehicle
8 **for a specified period, not in excess of a school year beginning in**
9 **September and ending in the June following,** while enrolled in a
10 course of behind-the-wheel automobile driving education approved
11 by the State Department of Education and conducted in a public,
12 parochial or private school of this State, which special learner's
13 permit shall be issued in lieu of the learner's permit provided for
14 in R. S. 39:3-13.

15 The special learner's permit described above shall be retained
16 in the office of the school principal at all times except during such
17 time as the person to whom the permit is issued is undergoing
18 behind-the-wheel automobile driving instruction.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill makes a technical amendment to the present statutes to allow boards of education to conduct driver education during the entire year thus permitting the students a greater opportunity to participate in the behind-the-wheel automobile driving education program.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
