INTRODUCED SEPTEMBER 19, 1974

By Senator RUSSO

Referred to Committee on County and Municipal Government

AN ACT providing for the appointment of alternate members to county planning boards in certain cases, and supplementing chapter 27 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The board of chosen freeholders may, by resolution, provide
2 for the appointment of alternate members to the county planning
3 board in accordance with the following:

4 a. Where the county planning board consists of six members
5 or less, the director of the board of chosen freeholders*,* with the
6 approval of ***[that body]*** *a majority of the board of freeholders*,
7 may appoint one alternate citizen member;

8 b. Where the county planning board consists of more than six
9 members, the director of the board of chosen freeholders*,* with the
10 approval of ***[that body]*** *a majority of the board of freeholders*,
11 may appoint two alternate citizen members. These members shall
12 be designated by the director as "Alternate No. 1" and "Alternate
13 No. 2" and shall participate in the planning board's decision in
14 rotation during the absence or disqualification of any citizen
15 member;

16 c. Where the county engineer is a member of the planning board,
17 the director of the board of chosen freeholders*,* with the approval
18 of ***[that body]*** *a majority of the board of freeholders*, may
19 appoint the assistant or deputy county engineer to serve as an
20 alternate to the county engineer;

21 d. The director of the board of chosen freeholders*,* with the
21A approval of ***[that body]*** *a majority of the board of freeholders*,
21B may appoint a member of the board of chosen freeholders to serve
21C as an alternate to the two freeholder members.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

22 Alternate members shall be appointed for terms to expire at
23 the same time as the terms of the regular members for whom they
24 are alternates. An alternate member shall be entitled to sit with and
25 participate as a member in any hearing before the board. Any
26 alternate member who has attended the full hearing or hearings
27 may participate in the board's decision during the absence or
28 disqualification of any regular member for whom he is an alternate.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

This bill provides for the appointment of alternate members to county planning boards, and stipulates the number to be appointed in given circumstances. The committee's amendments are stylistic and clarificatory only.

Senate Bill No. 1390 authorizes any county board of chosen freeholders to provide, by resolution, for the appointment of alternate members to the county planning board, and sets out the procedures and conditions for making such appointments.

The director of the board of chosen freeholders shall, with the approval of said board, appoint the alternate members as follows:

1. In the case of planning boards with six members or less, one alternate citizen member may be appointed to the planning board;
2. In the case of planning boards with more than 6 members, 2 alternate citizen members may be appointed;
3. If the county engineer is a planning board member, the assistant or deputy county engineer may be appointed to serve as an alternate to the county engineer;
4. One member of the board of chosen freeholders may be appointed to serve as an alternate to the 2 freeholder members, one of whom is the director of the board.

The terms of the alternate members shall expire at the same time as the terms of regular members for whom they are alternates. Alternate members shall sit at any hearing and participate as voting members during the absence or disqualification of any member for whom they are alternates.
