STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: APRIL 24, 1975

Assembly Bill No. 1084 authorizes any municipality to appropriate moneys for the payment of premiums on group life insurance contracts for civil defense and auxiliary police volunteers rendering service in said municipality. The maximum face value of any such group life insurance policy shall not exceed over \$10,000.00.

The Senate Committee Amendment omits civil defense volunteers from the provisions of the bill. The committee is of the opinion that civil defense volunteers, who are presently eligible for life insurance coverage pursuant to App. A:9-57.3, should be treated in separate legislation.
