AN ACT concerning the expansion of county assistance for the care of children afflicted with sickle cell anemia and amending P. L. 1972, c. 171.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1972, c. 171 (C. 9:14B-1) is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 1. The board of chosen freeholders of a county which has no
4 county home and hospital for children afflicted with sickle cell
5 anemia may appropriate not more than ~~[\$5,000.00]~~ \$10,000.00 each
6 year for the necessary expense incident to the diagnosis and treat-
7 ment of such children resident in the county under the age of 21
8 years, including the cost of surgical appliances, support and
9 maintenance of such children, investigation of cases, and necessary
10 traveling expenses incidental to the investigation and transporta-
11 tion of patients to a suitable home or hospital within the State
12 supported by public funds or private charity; provided, however,
13 that the board of chosen freeholders in a county of the first class
14 having a population in excess of 800,000 may appropriate not more
15 than ~~[\$10,000.00]~~ \$25,000.00 each year.

16 Before spending money for such purposes the board shall adopt
17 such rules and regulations as it deems desirable concerning the
18 requirements of residence and eligibility for such relief. Disburse-
19 ments shall be made through officers designated by the board for
20 that purpose on verified bills presented and approved as in the
21 case of other county expenditures.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

STATEMENT

This bill increases the amount of money a board of chosen freeholders of a county may appropriate for children afflicted with sickle cell anemia.

Assembly Bill No. 1760 increases, from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00, the amount which may be appropriated by any county for the diagnosis and treatment of sickle cell anemia; except that a county of the first class with a population of over 800,000 (the counties of Essex and Bergen) may increase their appropriations from the present \$10,000.00 to \$25,000.00.
