AN ACT concerning elections and amending R. S. 19:32-1 and R. S. 19:45-7.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State $\mathbf{2}$ of New Jersey:

1 1. R. S. 19:32-1 is amended to read as follows:

 $\mathbf{2}$ 19:32-1. The office of superintendent of elections in counties of 3 the first class in which such office has previously been established is continued and in those counties of the first class in which such 4 office has not been previously established, is hereby established. 56 The offices shall be filled by some suitable persons who shall be 7 nominated by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate and who shall hold office for the term of 5 years from the 8 9 date of appointment and until their successors are appointed and 10 have qualified. Each superintendent shall receive a salary of not less than [\$5,000.00] \$7,500.00 or more than [\$7,500.00] \$10,000.00 11 per annum as the board of freeholders of such county shall 1213 determine, to be paid by the county treasurer. The persons so appointed shall have their offices in the counties for which they are 14 appointed. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original 15 appointments, but shall be for the unexpired term only. 16

2. R. S. 19:45-7 is amended to read as follows: 1

219:45–7. The compensation of the members of the several county 3 boards shall be as follows:

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provided, however, that any increases herein granted shall be
effected only upon the approval of the board of chosen freeholders
in the county affected.

13 The compensation fixed and determined under any of the fore-14 going classifications shall include all services rendered by any 15 county board in conducting all elections, and in connection with any 16 recount or recheck after any such election.

The members of the county board in counties other than counties of the first class and in counties of the first class not having a superintendent of elections who shall be elected as chairman and secretary thereof and who shall perform the duties of chairman and secretary thereof shall each receive an additional compensation of one-half of the compensation of the individual members of the board.

24The commissioner of registration in a county of the first class 25having a superintendent of elections shall receive not less than [\$2,500.00] \$7,500.00 nor more than [\$7,500.00] \$10,000.00, as shall 26be determined by the county board of freeholders, for services 2728performed as such commissioner of registration, and the commissioner of registration in a county of the second class having a 2930 superintendent of elections shall receive [\$1,000.00] \$2,500.00 per annum for services performed as such commissioner of registration, 31and for such services performed by a commissioner of registration 3233 in a county not having a superintendent of elections additional compensation shall be paid to such commissioner in an amount 3435equal to 50% of his salary as member and secretary of the county 36 board. In counties of the second class and in counties of the first class not having a superintendent of elections where a member of 37 38 the county board serves as commissioner of registration, he shall receive no additional compensation for the performance of his 39 duties as such commissioner unless he shall devote his full time 40to the performance of his duties as member of the county board, 41 42secretary thereof, and commissioner of registration. "Full time" 43as here used means such time as is duly required of employees in 44 the office of the county board.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill increases the salaries of superintendents of elections in counties of the first class, members of several county boards of elections, and the commissioners of registration of first-class and second-class counties.
