

AN ACT concerning leave of absence from public employment and amending R. S. 38:23-2.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

1 1. R. S. 38:23–2 is amended to read as follows:

 $\mathbf{2}$ 38:23-2. The head of every public department and of every court 3 of this State, every superintendent or foreman on the public works of this State, the heads of the county offices of the several counties 4 5and the head of every department, bureau and office in the government of the various municipalities, shall give a leave of absence 6 with pay to every person in the service of the State, county or mu-7 nicipality who is a duly authorized representative of the Grand 8 9 Army of the Republic, United Spanish-American War Veterans, Disabled American Veterans of the World War, Veterans of 10Foreign Wars, Ladies Auxiliaries of Veterans of Foreign Wars, 11 12Ladies Auxiliary, Veterans of World War I of the U.S.A., American Gold Star Mothers, Indian War Veterans, American Legion, 13 American Legion Auxiliary, Jewish War Veterans of the United 14States, Ladies Auxiliary, Department of New Jersey, Jewish War 15Veterans of the U.S.A., Catholic War Veterans of the United 16States, Ladies Auxiliary of New Jersey State Department, Catholic 17 War Veterans, The 369th Veterans Association, Incorporated, 18Women's Overseas Service League, American Veterans World 19 War II, Reserve Officers Association of the United States, Marine 20Corps League of the United States, Army and Navy Legion of 2122Valor, the Twenty-ninth Division Association, Council of State Employees, War Veteran Public Employees Association, New Jer-23sey Civil Service Association, Blind Veterans Association of New $\mathbf{24}$ Jersey, Army and Air National Guard Association of New Jer-25EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

sey, The National Guard Association of the United States, The 2627United States Coast Guard Auxiliary, Navy League, Veterans of World War I of the United States of America, Polish Legion of 28American Veterans, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Ladies 2930 Auxiliary, the Italian American War Veterans of the United States, 31Incorporated, [and] the Ladies Auxiliary, Italian American War 32Veterans of the United States, Incorporated, *[and]* the New 33 Jersey Firemen's Association * and the New Jersey State Exempt 33A Firemen's Association*, to attend any State or national conven-34tion of such organization.

35 A certificate of attendance to the State convention or encamp-36 ment shall, upon request, be submitted by the representative so 37 attending.

38 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel 39 to and from the convention. No person shall be entitled to a total 40 of more than 5 days leave of absence with pay each calendar year **41** 42for the purpose of attending, as authorized representative, the State or national convention of one or more of the above enumer-43 ated organizations. The leaves of absence authorized hereunder 44 shall not be cumulative and any unused leaves shall be canceled at 45the end of any given year. 46

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The purpose of this bill is to add the New Jersey Firemen's Association and the New Jersey State Exempt Firemen's Association to the list of those organizations whose members are eligible for leaves of absence with pay from the service of the State, county or municipality, pursuant to R. S. 38:23–2, to attend, as duly authorized representatives, any State or national convention of their organizations.
