AN ACT concerning county detectives and investigators, and amend-
ing N. J. S. 2A:157-9 and N. J. S. 2A:157-16.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:157-9 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:157-9. In counties of the sixth class there may be appointed
3 not in excess of **[four]** *six* county detectives, of whom one may be
4 designated chief of county detectives *and one captain of county*
5 *detectives*; their annual salaries shall be fixed as follows: chief of
6 county detectives, not less than \$7,500.00; *captain of county detec-*
7 *tives, not less than \$6,500.00*; and other county detectives, not less
8 than \$5,500.00.

1 2. N. J. S. 2A:157-16 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:157-16. In counties of the sixth class there may be appointed
3 not in excess of **[four]** *six* county investigators, who shall be paid
4 annual salaries of not less than \$5,000.00.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

Senate Bill No. 1526 authorizes the prosecutor in any county of the sixth class (that is, Cape May) to increase from four to six the number of county detectives, creates the new office of captain of county detectives and provides a minimum salary schedule for said office.

Section 2 of the bill increases from four to six the number of county investigators that may be appointed by the prosecutor of said county.

FISCAL NOTE TO

Senate Bill No. 1526 authorizes the prosecutor in any county of the sixth class (that is, Cape May) to increase from four to six the number of county detectives, creates the new office of captain of county detectives and provides a minimum salary schedule for said office.

Section 2 of the bill increases from four to six the number of county investigators that may be appointed by the prosecutor of said county.

The Division of Budget and Accounting estimates that enactment of this legislation would require an additional expenditure by the county affected of \$22,000.00 in fiscal 1975-76, \$23,320.00 in fiscal 1976-77 and \$24,700.00 in fiscal 1977-78.

The fiscal note is based on an estimate of costs rather than actual cost information.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.
