AN ACT concerning school elections and amending
N. J. S. 18A:14-62.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 18A:14-62 is amended to read as follows:

2 18A:14-62. The secretary of the board of education shall, within
3 5 days after the date of the election, forward a sealed package con-
4 taining a statement of the canvass of the votes in the school dis-
5 trict, the ballots, including the irregular ballots, the poll lists and
6 the tally sheets to the county superintendent who shall preserve
7 them for 1 year.

8 *All poll lists forwarded to the county superintendent under this*
9 *section shall be made available for public inspection during the year*
10 *in which they are to be preserved.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The purpose of this bill is to require that all election poll lists be made available for public inspection during the 1-year period following elections.
