A Supplement to the "State Uniform Construction Code Act," approved October 7, 1975 (P. L. 1975, c. 217).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 2 of said body or official, which appointed the persons serving as fire
- 3 prevention officials on the effective date of the "State Uniform
