PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Senator BEADLESTON

An Act to amend "An act concerning motor vehicles and supplementing Title 39 of the Revised Statutes," approved May 28, 1949 (P. L. 1949, c. 280).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Section 3 of P. L. 1949, c. 280 (C. 39:4-206) is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3. The director shall issue to such applicant, also, a certificate of
- 4 such design as shall be determined by the director, indicating that
- 5 a special vehicle identification card has been issued for the motor
- 6 vehicle designated therein, which shall be pasted on the lower right-
- 7 hand corner of the windshield of the motor vehicle for which it is
- 8 issued, and metal insignia or marker or both of such design as
- 9 shall be determined by the director which shall be attached to the
- 10 license plate or plates of the motor vehicle for which such identifica-
- 11 tion card and certificate have been issued.
- 12 In lieu of the metal insignia or marker, the director may issue
- 13 license plates bearing the national wheelchair symbol which shall
- 14 be attached to the motor vehicle for which such identification card
- 15 and certificate have been issued.
- 16 The fee for the issuance of such plates shall be *[\$3.00]*
- 17 *\$10.00*.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect 60 days after enactment.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.





Senate Bill No. 418 provides for the issuance of license plates bearing the national wheelchair symbol which shall be attached to the motor vehicle for which such identification card and certificate have been issued.

The Division of Budget and Accounting estimates that enactment of this legislation would require a State expenditure of \$9,000.00 in fiscal 1974-75, \$450.00 in fiscal 1975-76 and \$495.00 in fiscal 1976-77. The above estimate assumes that all 3,000 persons now using a marker or metal insignia will opt for the new plates provided and is, therefor, an absolute maximum cost.

The fiscal note is based on actual cost information.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.

The Official Copy Reprint of Senate Bill No. 418 permits the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates bearing the national wheelchair symbol to qualifying amputees, which license plates shall be attached to the motor vehicle for which such identification card and certificate have been issued.

The Division of Budget and Accounting estimates that enactment of this legislation would increase the revenues of the State by \$12,000.00 in fiscal 1974-75, \$600.00 in fiscal 1975-76 and \$660.00 in fiscal 1976-77.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.
