AN ACT concerning leave of absence from public employment, and
amending R. S. 38:23-2.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. R. S. 38:23-2 is amended to read as follows:

2 38:23-2. The head of every public department and of every court
3 of this State, every superintendent or foreman on the public works
4 of this State, the heads of the county offices of the several counties
5 and the head of every department, bureau and office in the govern-
6 ment of the various municipalities, shall give a leave of absence
7 with pay to every person in the service of the State, county or
8 municipality who is a duly authorized representative of the Grand
9 Army of the Republic, United Spanish-American War Veterans,
10 Disabled American Veterans **[of the World War]**, *Disabled*
11 *American Veterans' Auxiliary*, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Ladies
12 Auxiliaries of Veterans of Foreign Wars, Ladies Auxiliary,
13 Veterans of World War I of the U. S. A., American Gold Star
14 Mothers, Indian War Veterans, American Legion, American Legion
15 Auxiliary, Jewish War Veterans of the United States, Ladies
16 Auxiliary, Department of New Jersey, Jewish War Veterans of
17 the U. S. A., Catholic War Veterans of the United States, Ladies
18 Auxiliary of New Jersey State Department, Catholic War Veterans,
19 The 369th Veterans Association, Incorporated, Women's Overseas

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill
is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

26 National Guard Association of New Jersey, The National Guard

28 Auxiliary, Navy League, Veterans of World War I of the United
29 States of America, Polish Legion of American Veterans, Polish
30 Legion of American Veterans, Ladies Auxiliary, the Italian

33 United States, Incorporated, to attend any State or national
34 convention of such organization.

35 A certificate of attendance to the State convention or encamp-
36 ment shall, upon request, be submitted by the representative so
37 attending.

38 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration
39 of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel
40 to and from the convention. No person shall be entitled to a total
41 of more than 5 days leave of absence with pay each calendar year
42 for the purpose of attending, as authorized representative, the
43 State or national convention of one or more of the above enumer-
44 ated organizations. The leaves of absence authorized hereunder
45 shall not be cumulative and any unused leaves shall be canceled at
46 the end of any given year.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

The purpose of this bill is to include the duly authorized representatives of the Disabled American Veterans' Auxiliary among those State employees who are eligible for leaves of absence with pay to attend any State or national convention of the organization.

This bill amends present law to include the Disabled American Veteran's Auxiliary among the organizations for which leave of absence with pay may be granted to public employees who are authorized representatives for the purpose of attending the State or national convention of such organizations.

FISCAL NOTE TO
SENATE, No. 578

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: FEBRUARY 10, 1975

Senate Bill No. 578 grants leave of absence with pay to any public employee, who is an authorized representative, to attend a convention of the Disabled American Veterans' Auxiliary.

Based on the 1973 annual report, considering the number of delegates, convention days, organizations and the average daily wage rate, the Department of Civil Service estimates that enactment of this legislation would require the payment for non-productive time of \$87.00 in fiscal 1974-75, \$183.00 in fiscal 1975-76 and \$192.00 in fiscal 1976-77. Enactment would not require the budgeting of any additional money.

The fiscal note is based on an estimate of costs rather than actual cost information.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.
