The Assembly Education Committee favorably reports Assembly Bill No. 1499 with committee amendments.

As amended, this bill imposes new reporting requirements on school business administrators in order to ensure that the school district is in compliance with all federal and State laws, rules, and regulations relating to district contracts. The bill directs the school business administrator to submit a written report to the board of education on school district contracts by July 1 of each school year. Under the bill, the report must include: a list of all district contracts that will be awarded, subject to renewal, or expire during the school year; and an explanation of all applicable federal and State laws, rules, and regulations relating to those contracts. The bill also provides that prior to the execution, extension, or renewal of a school district contract that was not included in the report, the school business administrator must notify the board of all applicable federal and State laws, rules, and regulations relating to the contract.

The committee amended the bill to impose the reporting requirements on the school business administrator, rather than the superintendent of schools.

This bill was pre-filed for introduction in the 2014-2015 session pending technical review. As reported, the bill includes the changes required by technical review, which has been performed.
