STATE OF NEW JERSEY

PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1970 SESSION

By Senators BEADLESTON and HAUSER

- AN ACT concerning the numbering and printing of the laws by the Secretary of State and supplementing chapter 3 of Title 1 of the Revised Statutes.
- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Every bill and joint resolution enacted into law during the 2 first annual session of a Legislature shall be numbered and printed 3 as a public law of that legislative year. Every bill and joint reso-4 lution introduced in the first annual session of a Legislature and 5 enacted into law after the convening of the second annual session 6 of the same Legislature shall be numbered and printed as a public 7 law of the legislative year of the second annual session.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

Enactment of this bill would permit the closing of the annual edition of the laws as to even number year sessions, beginning with 1970, on the second Tuesday in January of the following year.
