

INTRODUCED JANUARY 20, 1970

AN ACT relating to the qualifications of the State Commissioner of Health and amending P. L. 1947, chapter 177, s. 3.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 3 of P. L. 1947, chapter 177 (C. 26:1A-3) is amended 2 to read as follows:

3 3. The head and chief administrative officer of the department shall be the State Commissioner of Health, who shall be a duly 4 licensed physician, a graduate of a regularly chartered and legally $\mathbf{5}$ constituted medical school or college, with skill in sanitary science, 6 and with at least 5 years of full time experience in an administra-7 tive or executive capacity in a public health agency or with expe-8 rience in the field of community health facilities planning and at 9 least 10 years of full time experience in community medical service. 10He shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent 11 of the Senate, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor dur-12ing the Governor's term of office and until the appointment and 13 qualification of the commissioner's successor. 14 He shall devote his entire time and attention to the duties of his 15

16 office shall receive such salary as shall be provided by law.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
