An Act concerning the collection of taxes and assessments, and amending section 54:4-67 of the Revised Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 54:4-67 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 54:4-67. The governing body of each municipality may by res-
- 4 olution fix the rate of discount to be allowed for the payment of
- 5 taxes or assessments previous to the date on which they would be-
- 6 come delinquent. The rate so fixed shall not exceed 6% per annum,
- 7 shall be allowed only in case of payment on or before the thirtieth
- 8 day previous to the date on which the taxes or assessments would
- 9 become delinquent. The governing body may also fix the rate of
- 10 interest to be charged for the nonpayment of taxes or assessments
- 11 on or before the date when they would become delinquent, and
- 12 may provide that no interest shall be charged if payment of any
- 13 installment is made within 10 days after the date upon which the
- 14 same became payable. The rate so fixed shall not exceed [8%]
- 15 *8% per annum on the first \$1,000.00 of the delinquency, and* 12%
- 16 per annum *on any amount in excess of \$1,000.00*.
 - 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
