An Act to amend "An act concerning regional transportation planning, providing for an interstate compact between the States of New Jersey, New York and Connecticut, creating the Tri-State Transportation Commission, prescribing the functions, powers and duties of the same and providing for the selection of New Jersey representatives," approved April 8, 1965 (P. L. 1965, c. 12).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Article V, Section 3, of the compact (C. 32:22B-15) of which
- 2 this act is amendatory, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. The commission shall continue in existence until June 30,
- 4 [1970] 1971. Thereafter it shall continue only upon the adoption
- 5 of concurrent legislation by the party states.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect upon the enactment by each of the
- 2 states of Connecticut and New York of legislation having like effect
- 3 as this act, but if each of such states shall have already enacted
- 4 such legislation, this act shall take effect immediately.
