PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1970 SESSION

By Assemblymen SCHLUTER and WEIDEL

AN ACT concerning the New Jersey Historical Commission and amending section 18A:73-22 of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 18A:73-22 of the New Jersey Statutes is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 18A:73-22. There is hereby established in the Division of the  
4 State Library, Archives and History of the State Department of  
5 Education the New Jersey Historical Commission to be composed  
6 of **[10]** *12* members as follows:

7 (a) The State Librarian and the supervisor of the historic sites  
8 section of the Department of Conservation and Economic Develop-  
9 ment; and

10 (b) Six citizens of the State to be appointed by the Governor  
11 with the advice and consent of the Senate, all of whom shall be  
12 chosen by reason of their expertise in New Jersey history and  
13 qualified by academic achievement or professional affiliation, who  
14 shall serve for terms of 3 years and until the appointment and  
15 qualification of their successors except that of the members first  
16 appointed 2 shall be appointed for terms of 1 year, 2 for terms of  
17 2 years and 2 for terms of 3 years.

18 (c) **[One member]** *Two members* of the Senate to be appointed  
19 by the President thereof, and **[one member]** *2 members* of the  
20 General Assembly to be appointed by the Speaker thereof. *No more*  
21 *than one of the Senate and Assembly members shall be members*  
22 *of the same political party.* Anyone appointed pursuant to this  
23 subsection shall serve as a member of the commission until the  
24 expiration of his term as Senator or Assemblyman, as the case  
25 may be, during which he was appointed.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
