- 1. Section 6 of P. L. 1968, chapter 281 (C. 1:19-6) is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 6. The commission shall prepare and submit to the Governor
- 4 and the Legislature, such interim reports from time to time as it
- 5 shall determine and on or before April 1, [1970] 1971, a final re-
- 6 port containing its basic policy determinations and the principal
- 7 proposals for substantive change in the law, together with the text
- 8 of its proposed revision.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
