## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

## INTRODUCED MAY 7, 1970

By Senators SEARS and CRABIEL

(Without Reference)

AN ACT concerning claims against the State.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Except for actions founded upon the Constitution of this State 2 or the United States or an express provision of the statutory laws 3 of this State, no action shall be instituted or continued against the 4 State or any department or other agency thereof for the recovery 5 of money damages, whether based on contract or tort, where the 6 cause of action accrues prior to July 1, 1971.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
