AN ACT concerning beauty culture, and amending R. S. 45:4A-12.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 45:4A-12 is amended to read as follows:

2 45:4A-12. Any person who has practiced beauty culture or acted
3 as manager of a beauty shop under a certificate, license or permit
4 for not less than 3 years **next preceding June 29, 1935** in another
5 State, territory, or the District of Columbia, or any person who
6 practiced beauty culture in this State for at least 1 year next pre-
7 ceding June 29, 1935, and is thus engaged in this State on said June
8 29, 1935, may secure the certificate of registration or license re-
9 quired by this chapter without examination or compliance with
10 other requirements as to age or education, provided such person
11 shall make an application to the department for registration and
12 license within 90 days after **[said June 29, 1935]** *this amendatory*
13 *act*. Such application shall be accompanied by a certificate of a
14 practicing physician that the applicant was examined and is free
15 from all contagious and infectious diseases, and the registration or
16 license fee required by this chapter. Any person studying beauty
17 culture in an accredited school of beauty culture as required by this
18 chapter on said June 29, 1935, shall receive credit for such time
19 and studies without compliance with the requirements of this
20 chapter as to age and preliminary education; provided, such
21 persons shall make application to the department for registration
22 as a student within 90 days after said June 29, 1935.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

2 45:4A-12. Any person who has practiced beauty culture or acted
3 as manager of a beauty shop under a certificate, license or permit

5 of Columbia, or any person who practiced beauty culture
5A in this State for at least 1 year next preceding June 29,
6 1935, and is thus engaged in this State on said June 29, 1935, may
7 secure the certificate of registration or license required by this
8 chapter without examination or compliance with other require-
9 ments as to age or education, provided such person shall make an
10 application to the department for registration and license within
11 90 days after **[said June 29, 1935]** *this amendatory act*. Such ap-
12 plication shall be accompanied by a certificate of a practicing phy-
13 sician that the applicant was examined and is free from all con-
14 tagious and infectious diseases, and the registration or license fee
15 required by this chapter. Any person studying beauty culture
16 in an accredited school of beauty culture as required by this chapter
17 on said June 29, 1935, shall receive credit for such time and studies
18 without compliance with the requirements of this chapter as to age
19 and preliminary education; provided, such persons shall make
20 application to the department for registration as a student within
21 90 days after said June 29, 1935.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
