AN ACT concerning beauty culture, and amending R. S. 45:4A-12.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. R. S. 45:4A–12 is amended to read as follows:

 $\mathbf{2}$ 45:4A-12. Any person who has practiced beauty culture or acted as manager of a beauty shop under a certificate, license or permit 3 for not less than 3 years *next preceding June 29, 1935* in another 4 State, territory, or the District of Columbia, or any person who 56 practiced beauty culture in this State for at least 1 year next pre-7ceding June 29, 1935, and is thus engaged in this State on said June 8 29, 1935, may secure the certificate of registration or license required by this chapter without examination or compliance with 910other requirements as to age or education, provided such person shall make an application to the department for registration and 11 12license within 90 days after [said June 29, 1935] this amendatory act. Such application shall be accompanied by a certificate of a 13practicing physician that the applicant was examined and is free 14from all contagious and infectious diseases, and the registration or 15 license fee required by this chapter. Any person studying beauty 16culture in an accredited school of beauty culture as required by this 17chapter on said June 29, 1935, shall receive credit for such time 18 and studies without compliance with the requirements of this 19 chapter as to age and preliminary education; provided, such 20persons shall make application to the department for registration 21as a student within 90 days after said June 29, 1935. 22

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Any person who has practiced beauty culture or acted as manager of a beauty shop under a certificate, license or permit 3 for not less than 3 years in another State, territory or the District 4 of Columbia, or any person who practiced beauty culture 5 5A in this State for at least 1 year next preceding June 29, 6 1935, and is thus engaged in this State on said June 29, 1935, may secure the certificate of registration or license required by this $\mathbf{7}$ 8 chapter without examination or compliance with other require-9 ments as to age or education, provided such person shall make an application to the department for registration and license within 10 11 90 days after [said June 29, 1935] this amendatory act. Such application shall be accompanied by a certificate of a practicing phy-12sician that the applicant was examined and is free from all con-13 14 tagious and infectious diseases, and the registration or license fee required by this chapter. Any person studying beauty culture 15 in an accredited school of beauty culture as required by this chapter 16 on said June 29, 1935, shall receive credit for such time and studies 17 without compliance with the requirements of this chapter as to age 18 and preliminary education; provided, such persons shall make 19 application to the department for registration as a student within 202190 days after said June 29, 1935.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
