An Act concerning disorderly persons, and supplementing chapter 170 of Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Any person who discards or abandons in any public or private
- 2 place accessible to children, whether or not such children are tres-
- 3 passers, any intact television picture tube, or being the owner,
- 4 lessee or manager of such place, knowingly permits such abandoned
- 5 or discarded television picture tube to remain there in such con-
- 6 dition, is a disorderly person and shall be punished by a fine of
- 7 not more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not
- 8 more than 5 days, or both.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
