An Acr concerning the erection and use of rotating or flashing lights within 100 feet of the roadway of highways and supplementing chapter 4 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. On and after the effective date of this act no rotating or flash-
- 2 ing light which imitates or resembles rotating or flashing lights
- 3 such as are used by public and governmental agencies *or any public
- 4 utility* to indicate emergency or hazardous conditions shall be
- 5 erected or used within 100 feet of the roadway of a highway within
- 6 the State.
- 1 2. Every such prohibited light or signal is hereby declared to
- 2 be a public nuisance and the authority having jurisdiction over the
- 3 highway or the municipality in which the prohibited act takes place
- 4 is empowered to remove the same or cause it to be removed without
- 5 notice.
- 1 3. This act shall not apply to any rotating or flashing light used
- 2 to indicate an emergency or hazardous condition.
- 1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
