INTRODUCED JANUARY 26, 1970

AN ACT relating to assignments of mortgages offered for recording,  
and supplementing chapter 243 of the laws of 1964

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The county recording officer shall require the post-office ad-  
2 dress of any individual assignee of an assignment of a mortgage  
3 offered for recording under the act to which this act is a supple-  
4 ment, and the location of the principal office of any partnership,  
5 association or corporation named as assignee in any assignment of  
6 a mortgage instrument offered for recording under the act to which  
7 this act is a supplement.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
