AN ACT to amend "An act authorizing the creation by ordinance of the office of municipal administrator, and supplementing chapter 46 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes," approved December 26, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 367).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1968, chapter 367 (C. 40:46-2.2) is amended 2 to read as follows:

3 1. The governing body of any municipality, may by ordinance create the office of municipal administrator, to administer the busi-4 ness affairs of the municipality to have such powers, and perform 5 such duties other than those required by law to be exercised by the 6 governing body itself or by another officer, board or body, and 7 receive such compensation, as the ordinance creating such office 8 shall provide and as may from time to time otherwise be directed 9 by the governing body by ordinance. Such ordinance may provide 10 11 that a person appointed to the office of municipal administrator 12 need not be a resident of the municipality.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
