PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1970 SESSION

By Senators DUMONT and STOUT

AN ACT concerning fishing and supplementing article 2 of chapter
5 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. No person shall have in possession any natural bait, live or
2 preserved, any metal, plastic or wooden lures, plugs, spinners, flies,
3 or any such contrivance that might be attached to a line or placed
4 upon a hook for the purpose of catching fish, other than those
5 specified as legal while angling in waters designated as having
6 such restrictions under the Fish and Game Code, under a penalty
7 of \$20.00 for each offense.

1 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 1971.
