An Act to amend "An act providing for the licensing and regulation of convalescent and nursing home administrators, and supplementing chapter 11 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes," approved November 26, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 356).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

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- 1. Section 3 of the act of which this act is amendatory is amended 1
- 2to read as follows:
- 3 3. Upon receipt of an application for license and a license fee
- 4 of \$25.00, and an examination fee of \$50.00, the department shall

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to provide revenue to defray the costs of conducting the examinations provided for herein to ascertain the ability of administrators of convalescent homes or private nursing homes to perform the duties of such position.
