

AN ACT to amend "An act relating to, regulating and providing for the government of cities of the second class which now have or may hereafter have a population of less than 20,000," approved April 23, 1907 (P. L. 1907, c. 99).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 94 of chapter 99 of the laws of 1907 is amended to 2 read as follows:

94. In contracting for any public work or the purchase of any 3 supplies or materials involving an expenditure of [\$1,000.00] 4 \$2.500.00 or more, for such city or by or for any of the city de-5 partments, sub-departments or municipal officers not embraced in 6 a department, or by or for special commissions or boards, unless 7otherwise provided for in this act, proposals for the same shall 8 be first advertised for in 2 or more daily or weekly newspapers 9 published in such city, for not less than 3 nor more than 20 days 10and for not less than 3 insertions of such advertisement. Contracts 11 for expenditures of the city moneys for any public work or for the 12purchase of supplies or materials for any department of less than 13 **[**\$1,000.00 and more than \$200.00] \$2,500.00, shall be made by city 14 council either at a regular or special session thereof in such man-15ner as it may prescribe either by resolution or ordinance, but every 1617such contract shall be approved by the mayor, or, if disapproved by him, by $\frac{5}{7}$ of the entire members of city council. [Contracts 18 for public work or for the purchase of supplies or materials for 19 any department involving \$200.00 or less may be entered into by 20the commissioner of any department, and such contract, upon the 21 signing of a memorandum thereof by any such commissioner, shall 22in all respects be binding upon such city.] 23

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
