AN ACT concerning residence requirements for residents' licenses
issued by the Division of Fish and Game and amending R. S.
23:3-4.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 23:3-4 is amended to read as follows:

2 23:3-4. The licenses issued under this article shall be as follows:

3 a. A license issued to citizens of the United States above 14 years
4 of age, who have an actual and bona fide domicile in this State at
5 the time of the application for the license and who have had an
6 actual and bona fide domicile in this State for at least **[1 year]**
7 *6 months* immediately prior thereto. These licenses shall be of
8 four kinds and designated as the residents' firearm hunting and
9 trapping license, the residents' bow and arrow license, the residents'
10 fishing license and the residents' family fishing license. The Fish
11 and Game Council in the Division of Fish and Game of the Depart-
12 ment of Conservation and Economic Development shall have the
13 authority to adopt and promulgate regulations for said family
14 fishing licenses.

15 The residents' firearm hunting and trapping license shall
16 authorize its holder to trap and to hunt with hounds and firearms
17 only, and a fee of \$5.00 and an issuance fee of \$0.15 shall be charged
18 therefor. The residents' bow and arrow license shall authorize
19 its holder to hunt with bow and arrow only, and a fee of \$5.00 and
20 an issuance fee of \$0.15 shall be charged therefor. The residents'
21 fishing license shall authorize its holder to fish only, and a fee of
22 \$4.00 and an issuance fee of \$0.15 shall be charged therefor except

23 that in any case where the applicant is 70 or more years of age and
24 is otherwise qualified no fee shall be charged. The residents' family
25 fishing license shall authorize the parents or guardians and their
26 children, foster children or wards between the ages of 14 and 18,
27 named therein, to fish only. The fee for the parent license permit-
28 ting fishing only by the father or mother, or both, or the guardian
29 shall be \$8.00 with an issuance fee of \$0.15; and each child, foster
30 child or ward named therein shall be required to have and shall
31 be issued an individual supplementary license as a member of such
32 family at a fee of \$1.00 and an issuance fee of \$0.15. The license
33 shall be invalid from the date of its issuance when issued to a
34 person not entitled thereto hereunder. Any person, a resident of
35 this State, who is afflicted with total blindness, upon application
36 to the Division of Fish and Game shall be entitled to a residents'
37 fishing license without fee or charge.

38 b. A license issued to a person above 14 years of age not entitled
39 to a residents' license, authorizing him to trap and to hunt. These
40 licenses shall be designated as the nonresidents' and aliens' firearm
41 hunting and trapping license, and the nonresidents' and aliens' bow
42 and arrow license. The fee for each of these licenses shall be \$15.00,
43 and an issuance fee of \$0.15.

44 c. A license issued to a person above 14 years of age not entitled
45 to a residents' license, authorizing him to fish only. These licenses
46 shall be designated as the nonresidents' and aliens' fishing license
47 and the nonresidents' and aliens' 3-day vacation fishing license
48 valid for a period of 3 consecutive days and only obtainable after
49 June 1 of each year. The fee for these licenses shall be \$7.00 for
50 the annual fishing license, together with an issuance fee of \$0.15,
51 and \$3.50 and an issuance fee of \$0.15 for the 3-day vacation fishing
52 license.

53 Every license issued hereunder shall be void after December 31
54 next succeeding its issuance excepting the nonresidents' 1-day
55 hunting license which shall expire on the date of issuance, and the
56 nonresidents' and aliens' 3-day fishing license which is valid only
57 for 3 consecutive days after date of issuance.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
