AN ACT concerning fire districts, and amending R. S. 40:151-30.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 40:151-30 is amended to read as follows:

2 40:151-30. The fire commissioners in any fire district created
3 by the township committee may purchase motor, horse-drawn or
4 steam fire engines or other appliances or apparatus for the ex-
5 tinguishment of fires, and may purchase lands and erect buildings
6 for the housing of said apparatus and appliances, at a cost not
7 exceeding \$60,000.00 or 2% of the assessed valuation of the district,
8 whichever is larger, said money having been first raised and ac-
9 cumulated as provided in sections 40:151-31 to 40:151-34 of this
10 Title.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
