## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED MARCH 23, 1970

By Senator KAY

Referred to Committee on Judiciary

AN ACT concerning the courts, repealing N. J. S. 2A:171-3 and supplementing Title 2A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. It shall be lawful for a person to serve or execute, or cause 2 to be served or executed, on Sunday, any writ, process, warrant, 3 order or judgment in any civil or criminal action and such service 4 or execution shall be valid and effectual for all purposes to the 5 same extent as if said service or execution had been made on a day 6 of the week other than Sunday.

1 2. N. J. S. 2A:171–3 is repealed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
