INTRODUCED JANUARY 29, 1970

By Assemblymen HURLEY and CAFIERO

Referred to Committee on Judiciary

AN ACT exempting members of the armed forces and school teachers from jury service under certain circumstances, and amending N. J. S. 2A:69-2.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:69-2 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:69-2. The following persons shall be exempt from service
3 on any panel of grand or petit jurors:

4 a. Members or employees of police forces, State or local.

5 b. Members of any fire department or fire patrol, volunteer or
6 paid.

7 c. Persons appointed as fish and game wardens or protectors.

8 d. Regularly licensed and practicing physicians and dentists in
9 this State.

10 e. Members of State or Federal military, naval or air forces
11 (*on active duty*).

12 f. School teachers (*under contract as full time teachers*) while
13 their schools are in session.

14 g. Any person who has the actual physical care and custody of
15 a minor child and who gives written notice to the jury commis-
16 sioners of the county of his residence that jury service would
17 interfere with the care required for such child.

18 h. All officers and persons regularly employed by any agency
19 under the authority of the State Board of Control of the Depart-
20 ment of Institutions and Agencies, or regularly employed by
21 hospitals.

22 i. Telegraph and telephone operators and linemen and those di-
23 rectly engaged in the business of receiving and transmitting
24 messages by telegraph or calls by telephone.

- 25 j. Any person who is the holder of an exempt firemen's certifi-
- 26 cate issued pursuant to sections 40:47-52 to 40:47-59 of the Re-
- 27 vised Statutes or any other law.
- 28 k. Members of the State Legislature.
- 29 l. Members of first aid and rescue squads.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
