An Act concerning the State Board of Examiners and amending N. J. S. 18A:6-34.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. N. J. S. 18A:6-34 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 18A:6-34. There shall be a State Board of Examiners, consist-
- 3 ing of the commissioner ex officio and one assistant commissioner
- 4 of education, two presidents of State colleges, one county super-
- 5 intendent, one superintendent of schools of a Type I district, one
- 6 superintendent of a Type II district, one high school principal, Lone
- 7 high school teacher, one elementary school principal, one ele-
- 8 mentary school teacher and one librarian employed by the State
- 9 or by one of its political subdivisions [,] and four teaching staff
- 10 members other than a superintendent, principal or librarian, all of
- 11 whom shall be appointed by the commissioner with the approval of
- 12 the State board.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
