# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED MAY 4, 1970

AN ACT concerning temporary disability benefits and amending section 23 of chapter 110 of the laws of 1948 (C. 43:21-47).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 23 of chapter 110 of the laws of 1948 (C. 43:21-47) is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 23. Withdrawal from Federal treasury.

4 (a). The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to  
5 requisition and withdraw on or before December 31, 1948, the sum  
6 of \$50,000,000.00 from the amount of worker contributions hereto-  
7 fore accumulated in the State unemployment compensation fund  
8 and deposited in and credited to the account of this State in the  
9 unemployment trust fund of the United States of America,  
10 established and maintained pursuant to section 904 of the Social  
11 Security Act, as amended (U. S. Code Title 42, Section 1104), and  
12 to deposit such sum in the State disability benefits fund, estab-  
13 lished [by this act] *under the Temporary Disability Benefits Law.*  
14 The State Treasurer is further authorized and empowered to make  
15 such requisitions or withdrawals in accordance with such regula-  
16 tions relating thereto as may be prescribed by the United States  
17 Secretary of the Treasury. No portion of the amount requisitioned  
18 or withdrawn from the Federal Treasury shall be expended for the  
19 purpose of administering [this act] *the Temporary Disability*  
20 *Benefits Law.*

21 (b). *The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to*  
22 *requisition and withdraw within 90 days of this enactment, an*  
23 *additional sum of \$50,000,000.00 from the amount of worker con-*

24 *tributions heretofore accumulated in the State unemployment com-*  
25 *pensation fund and deposited in and credited to the account of this*  
26 *State in the unemployment trust fund of the United States of*  
27 *America, established and maintained pursuant to section 904 of the*  
28 *Social Security Act, as amended (U. S. Code Title 42, Section 1104)*  
29 *and to deposit such sum in the State disability benefits fund,*  
30 *established under the Temporary Disability Benefits Law. The*  
31 *State Treasurer is further authorized and empowered to make such*  
32 *requisitions or withdrawals in accordance with such regulations*  
33 *relating thereto as may be prescribed by the United States Secre-*  
34 *tary of the Treasury. If the balance in the State disability benefits*  
35 *fund as of December 31 of any calendar year, increased by the con-*  
36 *tributions credited thereto on or before, or as of January 31 im-*  
37 *mediately thereafter is in excess of \$100,000,000.00, the excess shall*  
38 *be withdrawn from the State disability benefits fund and deposited*  
39 *to the account of this State in the unemployment trust fund until*  
40 *the \$50,000,000.00 requisitioned and withdrawn under this subsec-*  
41 *tion has been returned and deposited to the account of this State in*  
42 *the unemployment trust fund. Such repayment to the unemploy-*  
43 *ment trust fund shall be considered in determining contribution*  
44 *rates by employers to the State disability benefits fund under R. S.*  
45 *43:21-7(e). No portion of the amount requisitioned or withdrawn*  
46 *from the Federal Treasury shall be expended for the purpose of*  
47 *administering the Temporary Disability Benefits Law.*

1     2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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#### STATEMENT

This bill provides for a \$50,000,000.00 transfer of worker contributions from the unemployment compensation fund on deposit in the unemployment trust fund established and maintained pursuant to section 904 of the Social Security Act, to the New Jersey disability benefits fund to assure the solvency of the disability benefits fund pending the receipt of increased contributions under companion legislation. The bill also provides for the return of the \$50,000,000.00 to the unemployment trust fund.
