An Acr to amend "An act to provide for the creation, setting apart, maintenance and administration of a city employees' retirement system in cities of the first class having, at the time of the enactment of this act, a population in excess of 400,000 inhabitants; and merging and superseding the provisions of pension funds established pursuant to article 2 of chapter 13, chapters 18 and 19, of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes, in said cities," approved November 22, 1954 (P. L. 1954, c. 218).

- 1 1. Section 26 of P. L. 1954, chapter 218 (C. 43:13-22.28) is
