An Acr concerning temporary disability benefits and amending section 23 of chapter 110 of the laws of 1948 (C. 43:21-47).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Section 23 of chapter 110 of the taws of 1948 (C. 43:21-47) is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 23. Withdrawal from Federal Treasury.
- 4 (a) The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to
- 5 requisition and withdraw on or before December 31, 1948, the sum
- 6 of \$50,000,000.00 from the amount of worker contributions hereto-
- 7 fore accumulated in the State unemployment compensation fund
- 8 and deposited in and credited to the account of this State in the
- 9 unemployment trust fund of the United States of America,
- 10 established and maintained pursuant to section 904 of the Social
- 11 Security Act, as amended (U. S. Code Title 42, Section 1104), and
- 12 to deposit such sum in the State disability benefits fund, estab-
- 13 lished under the Temporary Disability Benefits Law. The State
- 14 Treasurer is further authorized and empowered to make such
- 15 requisitions or withdrawals in accordance with such regulations
- 16 relating thereto as may be prescribed by the United States Secre-
- 17-19 tary of the Treasury. No portion of the amount requisitioned or
- 20 withdrawn from the Federal Treasury shall be expended for the
- 21 purpose of administering the Temporary Disability Benefits Law.
- 22 (b) The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to
- 23 requisition and withdraw within 90 days of this enactment, an
- 24 additional sum of \$50,000,000.00 from the amount of worker con-
- 25 tributions heretofore accumulated in the State unemployment com-
- 26 pensation fund and deposited in and credited to the account of this

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

27-28 State in the unemployment trust fund of the United States of America, established and maintained pursuant to section 904 of the 29 30 Social Security Act, as amended (U. S. Code Title 42, Section 1104) and to deposit such sum in the State disability benefits fund, 31 32 established under the Temporary Disability Benefits Law. The 33 State Treasurer is further authorized and empowered to make such requisitions or withdrawals in accordance with such regulations 34relating thereto as may be prescribed by the United States Secre-35 tary of the Treasury. If the balance in the State disability benefits 36 fund as of December 31 of any calendar year, increased by the con-37 38 tributions credited thereto on or before, or as of January 31 immediately thereafter is in excess of [\$100,000,000.00] \$75,000,000.00, 39 the excess shall be withdrawn from the State disability benefits 40 fund and deposited to the account of this State in the unemploy-41 ment trust fund until the entire \$50,000,000.00 requisitioned and 42 43 withdrawn under this subsection (b) has been returned and deposited to the account of this State in the unemployment trust 44 45 fund pursuant to the provisions of this subsection (b) and subsection (c) hereof. Such repayment to the unemployment trust 46 47-49 fund shall be considered in determining contribution rates by employers to the State disability benefits fund under R. S. 43:21-7(c). 50 No portion of the amount requisitioned or withdrawn from the 51 52Federal Treasury shall be expended for the purpose of administering the Temporary Disability Benefits Law. 53 (c) The State Treasurer shall transfer from the State disability 54 benefits fund to the clearing account of the unemployment com-55 56 pensation fund as established under R. S. 43:21-9, the sum of \$25,000,000.00. Such transfer may be made at such times and in such 57 installments as the State Treasurer may deem proper, except that 58 the total sum shall have been transferred by no later than April 59 30, 1971. Amounts transferred to the clearing account of the un-60 employment compensation fund under this subsection shall be 61 cleared immediately and shall be deposited with the Secretary of 62the Treasury of the United States of America in accordance with 63 the provisions of R. S. 43:21-9 (b). 64 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 1
