#### PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1970 SESSION

An Acr authorizing the maintenance of habeas corpus proceedings by grandparents to obtain visitation rights in respect to their infant grandchildren in certain cases, and supplementing chapter 2 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 4 parent or parents, may apply to the Superior Court for a writ of

- 7 as the best interest of the child may require, for visitation rights
- 8 for such grandparent or grandparents in respect to such child.
