STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 15, 1974

By Senators FELDMAN and MERLINO

Referred to Committee on County and Municipal Government

A SUPPLEMENT to the "Department of Community Affairs Act of 1966," approved November 23, 1966 (P. L. 1966, c. 293, C. 52:27D-1 et seq.) and repealing section 1 of article 7 of P. L. 1944, c. 112 (C. 52:27B-69).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The Local Finance Board in the Division of Local Government
2 Services in the Department of Community Affairs shall consist
3 hereafter of the Director of the Division of Local Government
4 Services as chairman and five members appointed by the Governor
5 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate. The two addi-
6 tional members first to be appointed to take office hereunder shall
7 be appointed to hold office, one for 3 years, and one for 4 years, and
8 thereafter all appointments shall be for 5 years. In case of a
9 vacancy by reason of expiration of term or otherwise the appoint-
10 ment shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term.

1 2. This act shall not affect the terms of office of the present mem-
2 bers of the board who shall continue to serve in office for the
3 remainder of their terms.

1 3. Section 1 of article 7 of P. L. 1944, c. 112 (C. 52:27B-69) is
2 repealed.

1 4. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to expand the membership of the Local Finance Board in the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs from three to five persons. The Director of the Division of Local Government Services shall continue to serve as chairman of the board and the terms of office of the present members of the board shall be unaffected.

Senate Bill No. 892 increases from three to five the number of members on the Local Finance Board in the Division of Local Government Services.

Considering the addition of two members at the current salary of \$6,000.00, the Department of Community Affairs states that enactment of this legislation would require an additional State expenditure of \$12,000.00. No additional support personnel is thought to be necessary.

The fiscal note is based on actual cost information.
