PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Assemblyman WOODSON

AN ACT concerning civil service employees in the State service, and amending R. S. 11:14-1.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. R. S. 11:14-1 is amended to read as follows.

2 11:14-1. The chief examiner and secretary shall, after consulta-
3 tion with the heads of departments and their principal assistants,
4 prepare, and after approval by the commission, administer regula-
5 tions regarding holidays, hours of work, attendance and annual
6 sick and special leaves of absence with or without pay or with re-
7 duced pay for permanent employees in the classified service; pro-
8 vided, however, that every permanent employee in the classified
9 service shall be granted at least the following annual leave for
10 vacation purposes with pay in and for each calendar year, except
11 as otherwise herein provided: **[Up to 1 year of service, 1 working**
12 **day's vacation for each month of service; after 1 year and up to**
13 **10 years of service, 12 working days' vacation, after 10 years and**
14 **up to 20 years of service 15 working days' vacation; and after 20**
15 **years of service, 20 working days' vacation.] Up to 1 year of**
16 **service, 1 working day's vacation for each month of service; after**
17 **1 year and up to 5 years of service, 12 working days' vacation;**
18 **after 5 years and up to 12 years of service, 15 working days' vaca-**
19 **tion; after 12 years and up to 20 years of service, 20 working days'**
20 **vacation; over 20 years, 25 working days' vacation.** Where in any
21 calendar year the vacation or any part thereof is not granted by
22 reason of pressure of State business, such vacation periods or parts
23 thereof not granted shall accumulate and shall be granted during
24 the next succeeding calendar year only. In determining all vacation
25 leave, the years of service of such employees prior and subsequent
26 to the adoption of this act shall be used.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

27 An employee who is a member of the National Guard or Naval
28 Militia of this State or of the military or naval forces of the United
29 States required to undergo field training therein, shall be entitled
30 to additional leave of absence with pay for the period of such field
31 training.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATE OF NEW JERSEY

ADOPTED MAY 16, 1974

This bill amends Title 11 to provide a more liberal vacation schedule for civil service employees in the State service. The present statute provides for 1 working day of vacation for each month of service up to 1 year's service. This schedule is maintained in this bill. The present statute provides for 12 working days of vacation after 1 year and up to 10 years of service. The amendment in this bill provides for 12 working days of vacation after 1 year and up to 5 years of service. The amendment also provides for 15 working days of vacation after 5 and up to 12 years of service. The present law provides for 15 working days of vacation after 12 years and up to 20 years of service. The amendment provides for 20 working days of vacation after 12 years and up to 20 years of service. The present law provides for 20 working days of vacation after 20 years of service. The amendment provides for 25 working days of vacation for employees in this category.
