
#### PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

#### By Assemblyman BARBOUR

An Act to amend "An act concerning leaves of absence of certain public employees to attend State or national conventions," approved August 3, 1955 (P. L. 1955, c. 188).

- BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1955, c. 188 (C. 11:26C-4) is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 1. The head of every public department and of every court of
- 4 this State, the heads of the county offices of the several counties and
- 5 the head of every department, bureau and office in the government
- 6 of the various municipalities, shall give a leave of absence with
- 7 pay to every person in the service of the State, county or munici-
- 8 pality who is a duly authorized representative of the New Jersey
- 9 State Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal Order
- 10 of Police, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association, Inc., [and]
- 11 the Uniformed Firemen's Association, or the New Jersey State
- 12 Association of Chiefs of Police, to attend any State or national
- 13 convention of such organization.
- 14 A certificate of attendance to the State convention shall, upon
- 15 request, be submitted by the representative so attending.
- 16 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration of
- 17 the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel
- 18 to and from the convention.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.



# FISCAL NOTE TO ASSEMBLY, No. 304

# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: JANUARY 28, 1974

Assembly Bill No. 304 grants leave of absence with pay for any public employee who is a duly authorized representative to attend a State or national convention of the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police.

The Civil Service Department feels that enactment of this legislation would not generate additional costs. It is not likely that a chief of police or an assistant chief would be replaced by someone who would receive additional compensation while on convention leave.

In compliance with written request received, there is hereby submitted a fiscal estimate for the above bill, pursuant to P. L. 1962, c. 27.

DATED: MAY 13, 1974

Assembly Bill 304 mandates that any authorized representative of the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police shall be granted time off with pay to attend any State or national convention of such organization. The leave of absence shall be for the period of duration of the convention with a reasonable time also allotted for travel.
