STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED MARCH 18, 1974

By Senators HORN and FELDMAN

Referred to Committee on Transportation and Communications

An Act to amend the "Transportation Act of 1966," approved December 12, 1966 (P. L. 1966, c. 301).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 12 of P. L. 1966, c. 301 (C. 27:1A-12) is amended to 2 read as follows:

12. To assist the commissioner in the performance of his Lad-3 ministrative] duties, [one of the assistant commissioners shall 4 be designated as executive director of the department by] the $\mathbf{5}$ commissioner [in writing, which designation shall be filed with the 6 Secretary of State] may appoint a deputy commissioner. [Such 7 designation shall continue in effect until the commissioner shall, 8 in the manner herein provided, designate another assistant com-9 missioner as executive director.] The [executive director] deputy 10 commissioner shall serve at the pleasure of the commissioner and 11 shall have such powers and duties as may be delegated to him by 12the commissioner from time to time Land shall receive no extra 13 compensation for performing such duties]. The deputy commis-14 sioner shall receive such salary as may be established by the 15commissioner with the approval of the President of the Civil Ser-16 vice Commission and the Director of the Division of Budget and 17Accounting. 18

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill will create the position of Deputy Commissioner in the Department of Transportation. The deputy commissioner shall assist the commissioner in the performance of his duties.

EXPLANATION-Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

Senate Bill No. 967 creates the position of Deputy Commissioner in the Department of Transportation.
