1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The provisions of this act shall apply to the following boards  
2 and commissions: The New Jersey State Board of Certified Public  
3 Accountants, the New Jersey State Board of Architects, the State  
4 Board of Barber Examiners, the Board of Beauty Culture Control,  
5 the Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors, the New Jersey  
6 State Board of Dentistry, the State Board of Mortuary Science of  
7 New Jersey, the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land  
8 Surveyors, the State Board of Marriage Counselor Examiners, the  
9 State Board of Medical Examiners, the New Jersey Board of  
10 Nursing, the New Jersey State Board of Optometrists, the State  
11 Board of Examiners of Ophthalmic Dispensers and Ophthalmic  
12 Technicians, the Board of Pharmacy, the State Board of Profes-

1 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 45 of the Revised

10    *\*Any board's or commission's charges established, prescribed*  
11    *or changed pursuant to this section shall be established, prescribed*  
12    *or changed to such extent as shall be necessary to defray all proper*  
13    *expenses incurred by the board or commission in the performance*  
14    *of its duties but such charges shall not be fixed at a level that will*  
15    *raise amounts in excess of the amount estimated to be so required.\**

1    3. This act shall take effect immediately.

**STATEMENT**

Currently, the professional boards and commissions under the jurisdiction of the Department of Law and Public Safety may alter their fee schedules only through legislation. This bill would enable any such board or commission to request the Attorney General to establish or change fees by rule pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act.
