AN ACT pertaining to certain professional boards and commissions, and supplementing Title 45 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1 1. The provisions of this act shall apply to the following boards and commissions: The New Jersey State Board of Certified Public $\mathbf{2}$ 3 Accountants, the New Jersey State Board of Architects, the State Board of Barber Examiners, the Board of Beauty Culture Control, 4 the Board of Examiners of Electrical Contractors, the New Jersey 5 6 State Board of Dentistry, the State Board of Mortuary Science of New Jersey, the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land $\overline{7}$ Surveyors, the State Board of Marriage Counselor Examiners, the 8 State Board of Medical Examiners, the New Jersey Board of 9 10 Nursing, the New Jersey State Board of Optometrists, the State Board of Examiners of Ophthalmic Dispensers and Ophthalmic 11 Technicians, the Board of Pharmacy, the State Board of Profes-12 sional Planners, the State Board of Psychological Examiners, the 13 State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers, the State Board 14 of Shorthand Reporting, the State Board of Veterinary Medical 15 16 Examiners, and the X-Ray Technician Board of Examiners.

1 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 45 of the Revised $\mathbf{2}$ Statutes or any other law to the contrary, any board or commission 3 named in section 1 of this supplementary act may by rule establish, prescribe or change the charges for examinations, licensures and 4 other services it performs, which rule shall first be approved by 5 the head of the department to which such board or commission is 6 assigned and shall be adopted in accordance with the provi-7 sions of the "Administrative Procedure Act," P. L. 1968, c. 410 8 9 (C. 52:14B-1).

*Any board's or commission's charges established, prescribed
or changed pursuant to this section shall be established, prescribed
or changed to such extent as shall be necessary to defray all proper
expenses incurred by the board or commission in the performance
of its duties but such charges shall not be fixed at a level that will
raise amounts in excess of the amount estimated to be so required.*
This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

Currently, the professional boards and commissions under the jurisdiction of the Department of Law and Public Safety may alter their fee schedules only through legislation. This bill would enable any such board or commission to request the Attorney General to establish or change fees by rule pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act.

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
