AN ACT to amend the title of "An act providing for the uniform administration of the alternate programs of benefits for certain members of the faculty and other eligible employees of the New Jersey College of Medicine and Dentistry, Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, the Newark College of Engineering, the Department of Higher Education, and the State and county colleges, and supplementing chapter 66 of Title 18A and repealing sections 18A:64C-11.1 to 18A:64C-11.9 (inclusive) and 18A:65-74 to 18A:65-85 (inclusive) of the New Jersey Statutes, and chapters 278 and 281 of the laws of 1967 and chapter 181 of the laws of 1968," approved December 22, 1969 (P. L. 1969, c. 242; C. 18A:66-167 et seq.), so that the same shall read "An act providing for the uniform administration of the alternate programs of benefits for certain members of the faculty and other eligible employees of the New Jersey College of Medicine and Dentistry, Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, the Newark College of Engineering, the Department of Higher Education, the State Department of Education, and the State and county colleges, and supplementing chapter 66 of Title 18A and repealing sections 18A:64C-11.1 to 18A:64C-11.9 (inclusive) and 18A:65-74 to 18A:65-85 (inclusive) of the New Jersey Statutes, and chapters 278 and 281 of the laws of 1967 and chapter 181 of the laws of 1968," and to supplement the body of said act.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:
