## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

#### PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Assemblyman BURSTEIN

An Acr authorizing counties and municipalities to enter into agreements to provide funds to maintain or increase public transportation service under certain circumstances.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1. The board of chosen freeholders of any county and the govern-1 2 ing body of any municipality within the county, may enter into an agreement for the purpose of providing funds to maintain or in-3 4 crease public transportation service for mass transit purposes on 5 established or expanded routes within the county or municipality. 6 No such agreement may be entered into unless the State of New 7- Jersey, acting by and through the Department of Transportation, Commuter Operating Agency, shall have agreed with the transpor-8 tation company providing service, or with the county, for payments 9 subsidizing such transportation service in accordance with the pro-10 visions of this act. It shall be lawful for the board of chosen free-11 holders and for the governing body of a municipality to appropriate 12and raise funds annually for the aforesaid purposes in the same 13manner as appropriations are made for other county or municipal 14purposes. 15

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: MAY 13, 1974

This bill permits counties and municipalities to enter into agreements to provide funds to maintain or increase public transportation services on established or expanded routes within the county or municipality. The bill further provides that the agreement may not be entered into unless the Commuter Operating Agency in the Department of Transportation shall have agreed with the company providing such service, or with the county, for payments subsidizing such service.

The bill provides that counties and municipalities may lawfully appropriate and raise funds annually for the purposes of the bill.
