PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

By Senator VREELAND

AN ACT concerning per diem compensation of certain constables serving the Superior and County Courts, and amending N. J. S. 2A:11-47.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State  
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:11-47 is amended to read as follows:  
2 2A:11-47. Except as otherwise provided by law, the constables  
3 of the several counties shall receive for each day and every day  
4 they are engaged in attendance upon the Law Division of the  
5 Superior Court and the County Court in their respective counties,  
6 the sum of \$5.00 or such greater sum not exceeding the sum of  
7 **[\$18.00]** \$25.00 as the boards of chosen freeholders of such respec-  
8 tive counties may, by resolution, determine; which shall be in full  
9 and in lieu of all mileage or other allowances authorized prior to  
10 March 23, 1926.

1 2. This act shall take effect January 1 next succeeding enactment.

Senate Bill No. 495 increases from \$18.00 to \$25.00 the per diem rate which the boards of chosen freeholders may, by resolution, provide to constables while serving as court attendants in the Law Division of the Superior Court or the County Court.
