- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 1 1. N. J. S. 2A:11-47 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 2A:11-47. Except as otherwise provided by law, the constables
- 3 of the several counties shall receive for each day and every day
- 4 they are engaged in attendance upon the Law Division of the
- 5 Superior Court and the County Court in their respective counties,
- 6 the sum of \$5.00 or such greater sum not exceeding the sum of
- 7 [\$18.00] \$25.00 as the boards of chosen freeholders of such respec-
- 8 tive counties may, by resolution, determine; which shall be in full
- 9 and in lieu of all mileage or other allowances authorized prior to
- 10 March 23, 1926.
