AN ACT concerning the organization meeting of Type II and regional district boards of education, and amending N. J. S. 18A:10-3 and N. J. S. 18A:13-12.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 18A:10-3 is amended to read as follows:

2 18A:10-3. Each board of education shall organize annually at a
3 regular meeting held not later than at 8 p.m.

4 a. In Type I districts on March 1, or on the following day if that
5 day be Sunday;

6 b. In Type II districts *on any day of the first week commencing*
7 *on the first Monday following the annual school election, except*
8 *that in districts having an appointed board of education the meet-*
9 *ing shall be held on March 1 or on the following day, if March 1 be*
10 *Sunday.*

11 If the organization meeting cannot take place on that day by
12 reason of lack of a quorum or for any other reason, said meeting
13 shall be held within 3 days thereafter.

1 2. N. J. S. 18A:13-12 is amended to read as follows:

2 18A:13-12. The board shall hold a regular meeting forthwith
3 after its first appointment, and annually thereafter *on any day of*
4 *the first week commencing* on the first Monday after the annual
5 school election of the regional district, at which it shall organize by
6 the election, from among its members, of a president and vice
7 president, who shall serve until the **[first Monday]** *organization*
8 *meeting* next succeeding the election of their respective successors
9 as members of the board. If any board shall fail to organize within
10 **[3 days after]** said **[date]** *week*, the county superintendent of the

11 county, or the county superintendents of the counties, in which the
12 constituent districts are situate, shall appoint, from among the
13 members of the board, a president and vice president to serve until
14 the **【first Monday】** *organization meeting* next succeeding the next
15 election.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

DATED: MAY 13, 1974

Currently, these sections (N. J. S. 18A:10-3 and 18A:13-12) require boards of education in type II school districts, including regional districts, to hold their annual organization meetings on the first Monday following the annual school election.

Assembly Bill No. 822 would allow these boards to hold their annual organization meetings on any day of the week following the week in which the annual school election is held.

In type II school districts, the members of the board of education are elected and the school budget is voted on by the residents of the district at the annual school election.
